August Having addressed some of the concerns regarding the potential reordering of the Sacraments of Initiation, I think it is important to reiterate that this is not a decision that has been made and which we are being asked to just accept. The proposal was meant to generate discussion and the official Synod Delegates will discuss this in more detail at their next meeting on September 9. The main reason, again, for considering this is to see how the reception of these sacraments should be addressed in a way that is "most favorable to promoting the discipleship and stewardship way of life." Even if the order doesn't change, a mindset shift is needed with regards to catechesis as life-long discipleship formation.

Building on that point, we can look at the next two proposed declarations which are closely linked to one another: They read as follows:

4. In order that cost not be a barrier for children to receive a Catholic education, our Catholic grade schools and high schools (K-12) will offer Catholic education without charging tuition to parents for all children whose parents agree to the terms of the Family School Agreement.

5. As a means of fulfilling the responsibility of all the Christian faithful (not just parents) to hand on the Catholic faith to the next generation, our parishes will pay for the tuition in Catholic grade schools and high schools (K-12) for all children of their parishes whose parents agree to the terms of the Family School Agreement.

In a nutshell, Catholic education plays an extremely critical role in building a culture of discipleship and we, as a diocese, need to find ways in making this opportunity for formation available to as many children as possible.

Since we don't have a Catholic school here in Rochester, it may be easy for us to pass over these two proposals and see them as applying to other parishes. In next week's bulletin, I will address how these two proposals are indeed worth our attention.
