



## May 27, 2018 Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Having completed the Easter season last Sunday with the celebration of Pentecost, we've returned once again to Ordinary

Time. As we do so, I've been reflecting on the many graces of the past few months, and I think one of my favorite experiences has been all of the First Communions we've witnessed throughout the Easter season. Our parish is pretty unique in that we don't have a single celebration like so many other parishes but spread the First Communions out throughout the Easter season. I'm always happy to see the joy that our children have as they receive Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time in their lives. I'm reminded of the line that Jesus said in the Gospel: "Amen, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:3)

I hope their witness of joy in receiving the Eucharist has been a point of reflection for you. I know it has for me. I find myself asking the question: "Do I have that same childlike excitement each time I receive the Eucharist?" Sadly, I don't know that I can say that I do, but seeing their joy inspires me to *want* to be more childlike when it comes to receiving this great gift.

One of the ways that the Church has invited us to deepen our love for Jesus in the Eucharist is through the celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known by its Latin title, *Corpus Christi*. In particular, the Church encourages the faithful to participate in a Eucharistic procession on that day as a sign of our love for Him, asking Him to rekindle that childlike joy of receiving Him into our hearts in Holy Communion.

Next Saturday at the 4:30 pm Mass, as we celebrate *Corpus Christi*, I have asked all of our First Communicants for this year to come to that Mass dressed in their First Communion outfits. At the end of Mass, we will do a short Eucharistic procession on our grounds. This will be an opportunity for them to have a shared celebration of this important time in their faith journey, but it will also be a great opportunity for us as a parish to recommit ourselves to being renewed in our love for Jesus, especially as He comes to us in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. I hope you're able to join us!
