## June 14, 2020 Corpus Christi

In the Spring of 2019, our diocese was blessed to ordain 8 transitional deacons, those who are in transition toward ordination to the priesthood. Already at that time, we started to look forward with eager expectation to 2020 for the historic celebration of ordaining these 8 men to the priesthood, the largest class for our diocese since 1964. We wondered how we would pull off such a major celebration, with an anticipated crowd that would likely exceed the capacity of our Cathedral. It was a good “problem” to have. Then...the Coronavirus hit.

For certain circumstances related to immigration, we ordained our two Polish deacons on May 2 with only 10 people in the entire Cathedral. Thanks to our livestreaming capabilities, their family and friends joined us virtually, and thanks to Bishop Paprocki knowing Polish, he was able to preach his homily in Polish and English. This coming Friday, June 19, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, we will ordain the remaining 6 men, in addition to ordaining one man (the brother of one of the 6 being ordained a priest) to the transitional diaconate. We are obviously limited to 25% capacity at the Cathedral, so many family and friends who would have come will be unable to be there in person for this joyous occasion, but at least they can join us via livestream.

I share all of that with you because this is a big deal for our diocese. And while the circumstances are not ideal, our diocese will be blessed in a way that few others will be blessed this year, and I hope that brings all of you a great deal of healthy pride. As Vocation Director, I am ecstatic and cannot wait for the celebration this Friday. All of you are invited to join us via livestream for the Ordination Mass at 6:00 pm. You can find the stream at <https://dio.org/live>. The actual celebration, however, is closed to the public.

Please keep these men in your prayers as they begin their ministry to our diocese. They will be great priests I have no doubt. And please pray for our seminarians who hope to join the ranks of priests to serve all of you one day, God-willing. In particular, let us pray for Nicholas Lindstrom, a son of our parish who has two years of formation under his belt, with six more to go. Pray also that more young men (even some from our parish) will respond to the call to consider the priesthood. Without priests, we cannot have the Eucharist, and

without the Eucharist, we cannot fully live as Catholics.

On this Corpus Christi Sunday, on which we celebrate that great gift of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, please know of how grateful I am to have had the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist for you almost every day for the past four years. This is my greatest joy and I pray that these past few months have strengthened our love for the Bread of Life.
