 This passage is the one that has come to mind as I have been reflecting on my time here as your Pastor at St. Jude. I am truly thankful for so many things I have been privileged to experience here. While it would take much more space to try to list them all, let me share a few of them with you.

I am thankful for the warm welcome that I received on day one, and every day thereafter, from so many of you. I am thankful for the opportunities to work with the children of the parish. I thoroughly enjoyed teaching the 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade PSR for two years. I loved preparing three different groups for the Sacrament of Confirmation. I enjoyed celebrating First Holy Communions. And all the other interactions with our young people – I am thankful for them all.

I am thankful for the privilege of being with families in their times of sorrow as they said goodbye to their loved ones who had died. I am thankful to have been able to pray the prayers of the Church for the deceased and to offer a word of encouragement about the hope we have in the Resurrection, a hope that believes that for those who have died in Christ, “life is changed, not ended.”

Most of all, I am thankful for being able to celebrate the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist with and for you. These two sacraments hold a key place in my life as a Catholic and as a priest, and it has been such a privilege to invite all of you to see the beauty of these sacraments and their impact for the good in our lives as disciples of Jesus.

I am grateful for the many words of appreciation that so many of you have shared with me over the past two months especially. If there has been any good, all the glory belongs to the Lord, not to me. I just thank God that I was able to cooperate with what He wanted to do through me for your good

over these past four years. So, for whatever good you may have experienced, please give thanks to the one through whom all good things come, our good and loving Heavenly Father!
