One of the things I usually look at when I come to a new parish is the back cover of our bulletin. I feel strongly that it is important to "FILL" up all the squares of those who advertise in support of our bulletin and parish. As I see it, we have 15 open 1 square spaces empty. I hope you would agree that this is something we must work on. I don't want to send a message that "our parish" is not good enough to find supporters for those empty spaces. I know that with the Pandemic has taken a toll on businesses.

Here is my proposal that I have made to seven businesses that I have asked to "come on board" our bulletin with their ad. The Ad will go on the approximately 11,000 bulletins we run a year. I promise that I will support all those who advertise, and I would ask that all our parish would support them also. We will have a "Sponsor of the Week" article in each bulletin, highlighting one special sponsor. If a restaurant, gas station, etc. I will go to this business at least once a month, if not more. I will mention them in my homilies and the columns I write in the bulletin for sure.

I spoke to the company in Quincy who we get our bulletins from, which is "Sunday Missal Service". Justin Haubrich, a fifth generation family member, does the ads. He has given us a great deal, when he saw how serious I was (we are) in making the bulletin the best it can be.

- 1 square black & white is \$250, 1 square in full color is \$312.00.
2 square black & white is \$438.00, 2 squares in full color is \$546.00.
3 square black & white is \$600.00, 3 squares in full color is \$748.00.
4 square black & white is \$750.00, 4 squares in full color is \$936.00.

These are reasonable prices. I appreciate all those businesses who are presently on our bulletin. Their support is a blessing. So far, Pasta House & Company, Rocket Fitness, Old Lux Restaurant, Dublin Pub have said YES to joining us.

Do you know of any others I could contact? I want the parish to take out one ad in support of vocations. Encouraging Fr. Alford's ministry is important. Encouraging vocations to the priesthood, religious life as sisters and brothers, permanent diaconate We should take this mission seriously. We are blessed currently to have one young man, Nick Lindstrom, in the seminary, discerning a call to the priesthood for our diocese. I have to believe ALL 128 PARISHES in our diocese have AT LEAST 1 parish vocation. Can you imagine if our diocese had 128 men and women actively in a discernment process. WOW !!! I believe it could happen if every parish would take responsibility for promoting VOCATIONS.

A gentle reminder that we are still required to wear face masks as we enter and exit the church building. And as always it is recommended to wear a mask during your entire time in the church building for the safety of all.

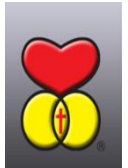


No Congregational singing at Mass for now:
