August 30, 2020 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Meeting A Lot of Great Folks”

When I arrived, I began to meet and talk with our parish staff. Our office manager Barb, our two deacons, Deacon Tom & Deacon Ray, Frances, the assistant in our Faith Formation ministry, Michael, our music ministry leader, Dean, our hard working custodian, and now recently added to our staff, Jennifer, as director of Total Catholic formation. I feel so blessed to work with them in a collaborative style outreach as we share our call to discipleship here at St. Jude's Parish.

As always when a priest moves, the daily mass crowd is one of the first groups we meet. Likewise, for me, coming to St. Jude's has given me the opportunity to already get to know 15-20 daily mass attendees. I appreciate their faith so much and their love for the eucharist/word. I already feel at home with them.

I have now met with both Pastoral Council and Finance Council and am really impressed with their roles and ministry of Leadership in our parish. For me, I love to have input from those in these positions. For me it is more helpful than folks that just come and say, “Whatever you want Father”, or “Whatever you think Father”. All of us are called to be “Pastoral leaders”, not just the pastor. They understand that and want to “heed the Lord's call” to give direction to our parish family.

I met with our entire team of Catechists for our PSR program. We had to make a serious decision to begin this year's program on September 9th with “Remote learning”. I could see our Catechists have a heart for this ministry and for the students they will do “formation” with. They will be committed to helping our parents guide their children in these formation nights.

This coming week I will meet on Monday night with our Buildings and Grounds Committee. Steve Warren chairs this committee and we hope to have 6-7 others at that meeting. Our parish plant looks great, and

we should be so proud of our buildings and Grounds.

On Wednesday, as we have “Drive Up” PSR resources night, we also will meet with 10-15 folks who will share in the “Art and Environment” committee ministry which looks at creatively enhancing our prayer space/sanctuary with environments which help to make our seasonal worship “Come Alive”. Hope to see you there. It is a wonderful ministry and can be enjoyed by many.

So, what is going on at St. Jude's? All bills are paid. Included in that group was a one-time yearly bill for \$12,697.00 for insurance on all our buildings. For an average that would be about what we collect on two weekend collections. THANKS !!!

We will be “Sealing” the parking lot in the coming weeks. Our buildings are in good shape. One improvement will be at the rectory. The sliding doors (from the inside of the house to the back outside deck) have now begun to come off their tracks due to the wood frame deteriorating. That will be fixed.

We have always taken 10% of the monies given to us from the interest on our land and used it for the purpose of helping the poor, and needy. We were approached by a parishioner inviting us to consider a request from another church (St. John's AME) Congregation. They have had some major damage to their main church/Hall. They need \$5800.00 to do these repairs, but do not have the financial resources to get this much needed renovation completed. Our parish will reach out in a spirit of ecumenical love and offer a gift of \$1200.00 (from the fund mentioned above), which will pay for all the materials needed to finish their project. I went and toured the properties and it really troubled my heart to see their problems. They were so grateful for our willingness to consider a gift of support. Great things are happening, thanks to the YES ministries of so many of our parishioners. May God bless you for all you do in Your YES to God.
